## **2010 Miss Maui Scholarship Program Information and Qualifications**

### ***QUALIFICATIONS:***

- Must be a High School Senior or 17 years of old or 24 years old by Dec. 31, 2010 (no older).
- Single and never married & never had a child and of good moral character.
- Must be part or full time registered high school senior, college or university student or seeking to attend a college or university on scholarships that are offered.
- No entry fees.
- U.S. Citizen and a Maui county resident for at least six months.
- MUST be born female. (With proof of your Birth Certificate).
- Open to ALL Maui County residents Only! (Maui, Molokai, Lanai).

### ***COMPETITION***

- Personal Interview (10 mins)
- Swimwear ( One or Two piece Swimsuit should be in good taste, No thongs or revealing swimwear. All competition swimwear must be approved by the Miss Maui Scholarship Organization ).
- Talent ( 90 seconds ). There are restrictions regarding your talent so please check with the committee before prepping for your talent. (example: No live bands, Samoan Fire or knife dance, props, etc).
- Evening Gown
- On Stage Question

You will also need to have a second Pink Evening Gown for the night of the pageant. All contestants are asked to wear a Pink Evening Gown for the crowning. You will not be judged in your pink evening gown. In Miss America, the contestants wear white evening gowns for their crowning. The color pink represents our island color.

Each contestant will have their own hometown title banner which will be presented to you on a special presentation appearance in front of the public. You will also be crowned as Miss Maui tradition of a Lei Po'o Haku instead of a tiara. Your family and friends will have the honor of witnessing you as a official contestant in the 2010 Miss Maui Scholarship Pageant.

The Miss America Organization as well as state and local preliminary scholarship programs are great supporters of The Children's Miracle Network Program (CMN). As a contestant you are asked to create a sponsorship website through the CMN [www.missamerica4kids.org](http://www.missamerica4kids.org) and raise a minimum pledge of \$100 or more. This is mandatory for the Miss America Scholarship Program. In order to become a registered and qualified contestant in this Miss Maui Scholarship Program you must complete this step first. After completion of your pledge, fill out your contestant entry form. This is very important for you to raise your minimum pledge of your \$100.00 to be qualified as a official contestant before participating in the 2010 Miss Maui Scholarship Program. So along with your contestant packet you need to provide proof of you fulfilling your CMN pledge.

- 1-A Copy of your Birth Certificate
- 2-A Copy of Drivers License or State ID
- 3-A Copy of High School Diploma or School transcript
- 4-A Copy of your CMN Pledge
- 5-A Copy of your Social Security Card
- 6-And a 3x5 (4x5/4x6) Headshot color or B/W

The copies of these documents and identification are for the sole purpose of the Miss Maui Scholarship Program, Miss Hawai'i Scholarship Program and Miss American Scholarship Program and will not be used for any other purpose.

ALL documents will be kept confidential and filed for any future use. At no time will any of these scholarship programs sell or give away any personal information.

This program allows the individual young women a chance to express themselves through confidence, style and education!
